



# Meetings and Events

- Tamarack offers flexible options for day, leisure, and corporate groups amidst an array of indoor and outdoor venues. From ski clubs and family reunions to weddings and corporate meetings, the resort's special events staff, on-site catering team, mix of accommodations, and recreation activities can be tailored to suit virtually any group.
- The Arling Center Conference Facility is a quaint hamlet of three buildings – a Chapel, Schoolhouse, and Grange – reflecting classic Idaho architecture. The buildings are situated around a central plaza atop a forested knoll, steps from Tamarack's Lodge at Osprey Meadows.
- The Center provides approximately 10,000 square feet of modern meeting space suitable for conferences, trade shows, retreats, weddings, family reunions and special events.
  - Chapel: Seating for 125
  - Grange: Lecture-style seating for 265, banquet seating for 150
  - Schoolhouse: Two rooms, accommodating 45 in each
- The Arling Center is named after two turn-of-the-century Idaho communities, Arling and the surrounding area called Center, which disappeared when Lake Cascade was flooded in 1948.
- Tamarack dedicated the rooms of The Arling Center to various families and individuals, who have played a significant role in the history of Valley County, including: the Pottenger Family, Barbara Morgan, Bill Leaf, the Rutledge Family, and the Downend Family.
