



# Winter Recreation

- **Alpine Skiing & Snowboarding:** Tamarack Resort offers 1,100 acres of lift-accessed terrain, including 41 marked trails and hundreds of acres of gladed tree skiing. The slopes are served by seven lifts including three high-speed quads, Tamarack Express, Summit Express, and Wildwood Express.
- **Terrain:** With a vertical drop of 2,800 feet, Tamarack's alpine slopes provide a wide variety of terrain for all ability levels, including an even mix of terrain—39% advanced, 44% intermediate, 17% beginner.
- **SuperPipe & Terrain Park:** Freeriders can test their mettle in Tamarack's 22-foot high, Olympic-sized Hells Canyon SuperPipe—one of just six in North America—and the resort's two terrain parks—1,600 vertical feet of the No Business Terrain Park and the Family Fun Park at the base of the mountain. Both feature a mixture of rails, obstacles, and trick features.
- **Nordic Skiing & Snowshoeing:** Twenty-five kilometers of machine-groomed trails for cross-country skiers featuring a full-width skating lane and classic tracks, along with a wide variety of terrain, scenic viewpoints, open meadows and forested corridors. Tamarack offers more than 15 kilometers of designated snowshoe trails. The Lyle Nelson Nordic and Snowshoe Trail System's elevation ranges from 4,800 to 5,400 feet. The Nordic/Snowshoe Center, located in the Lodge at Osprey Meadows, provides rental, retail, guided excursions and lessons.
- **Snowmobiling:** Tamarack has acquired the outfitting license to run its own snowmobiling operations. Leaving from the resort's 7700-foot summit, guests have access to more than 350 miles of groomed trails in the Payette River Mountains, along with endless miles of backcountry terrain in the Boise and Payette National Forests. Full-day and half-day tours available.
- **Guided Services:** Tamarack offers an array of guided full-day, half-day backcountry adventures led by expert guides knowledgeable of area history, flora and fauna. The Backcountry Experience utilizes snowcats and snowmobiles to take powder-hungry skiers and riders into 5,054 acres of advanced backcountry terrain to the immediate north and south of resort boundaries, under a special use permit from the US Forest Service.
- **Sports School:** Tamarack's certified instructors and coaches offer daily first-timer, private and semi-private lessons for all ages and abilities. The Wildhorse Youth Activity Center provides childcare and a Youth Sports School with specialized instruction in a designated beginner area on the snowfront, serviced by a beginner lift and 'magic carpet'
