rental equipment and amenities including motorized and self-propelled watercraft such as kayaks and stand-up-paddleboards. In collaboration with Idaho Watersports, Tamarack is proud to feature luxury pontoon and wake boats for rent. Once open, the facility will operate Monday through Thursday between 10am-6pm, and Friday through Sunday: 10am-8pm until Labor Day (water level dependent).
