



Summer Fact Sheet

Mountain Biking

Tamarack Resort has the region's only [full-service trail park](#), designed by experts of the International Mountain Biking Association (IMBA). The park features more than 36 Miles of lift-served downhill and foothills trails designed for all riding abilities, with access to endless miles of forest-service trails.

- 16 miles of downhill single-track
- 20 miles of single- and double-track foothills cross-country trails
- Challenge Park offering skill-testing teeter-totters, rocks, and other obstacles.
- Jump Park featuring multiple ramp jumps for all ages and skill levels.
- The site of 2020's NW Cup - the best downhill bike series in the Pacific Northwest

Hiking

There are [hiking trails](#) fit for everyone at Tamarack. Trail access from Discovery Square leads to beautiful meadows and lake views. More advanced trails can be found from the top of the Tamarack Express.

Zipline Tours

The [Zipline Canopy Tour](#) at Tamarack Resort is the #1 Zipline experience in Idaho. The tour swings over 1700 vertical feet of beautiful terrain. Get a thrill from eight different ziplines, reaching speeds of almost 30 miles per hour, two suspension bridges and a 105' tree house.

Guided River Tours

Providing [guided whitewater rafting](#) adventures on the Cabarton stretch of the Payette River. This thrilling experience allows visitors to see Idaho like never before. Tamarack offers full day trips lasting seven hours and express trips lasting five hours.

Waterfront Cabana

Located at Lake Cascade's State Park Poison Creek Recreation unit, the [Waterfront Cabana](#) is the outfitter for Tamarack's watersports. Options are endless from kayaking and paddleboarding to renting pontoon boats or wakeboats. The Waterfront Cabana is open daily from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Summer Sports School

From the mountain to the water, the [summer sports school](#) gives visitors the opportunity to learn the ins and outs of all summer activities. Summer instructors are certified by the Professional Mountain Bike Instructors Association and USA Waterski and Watersports.



Summer Trailblazers Program

[The Summer Trailblazers Program](#) is designed to give kids ages seven to 14 personal training in watersports and mountain biking. Join USA Waterski and Watersports certified instructors on the water Friday nights (5 p.m. – 8 p.m.) June 12, 2020 through August 14, 2020 for small group lessons on waterskiing, surfing and wakeboarding. PMBIA certified trainers are also available Sundays (2pm-4pm) beginning June 14th.
