



## SUMMER FACT SHEET

### New for 2024

- Grand opening of 18-hole championship Osprey Meadows Golf Course
- 2-acre grass-lawn amphitheater and stage on Tamarack's Ski Beach (formerly known as the snow front)—steps from The Village at the mountain's base. The stage is home to the Tamarack Summer Concert Series—a free weekly concert every Saturday featuring local and national touring artists.
- 70,000-square-foot event and social lawn space behind Lodge at Osprey Meadows—a scenic setting for weddings and group gatherings overlooking the golf course and Lake Cascade.
- Walking and biking trail connecting The Village to the Tamarack Express chairlift
- New downhill biking trails including:
  - Shark Bait: a 0.94-mile, black diamond flow trail
  - Project O: a 0.56-mile, black diamond technical trail
  - Hot Shot Extension: a 1.05-mile, black diamond technical trail
  - Los Azulejos Extension: a 1.01-mile, green flow trail

### Golf

The grand opening of the 18-hole championship [Osprey Meadows Golf Course](#) and the 19th Gambler's Hole will be held in early July. Driving range and putting green open for daily use May 25 (11 a.m.-4 p.m., Monday-Thursday; 10 a.m.-5 p.m., Friday-Sunday). Clinics and private lessons are available from Tamarack's certified PGA and Nicklaus Academies professionals for all ages and skill levels.

### Mountain Biking

The Tamarack Resort [Bike Park](#), designed by International Mountain Biking Association experts, features nearly 54 total miles of lift-served downhill and cross-country trails for all levels of riders, with access to endless miles of U.S. Forest Service trails. Guests can rent mountain, cross-country and e-bikes at Tamarack Outfitters, located in The Village. Meadow trails open Memorial Day weekend with seven-days-a-week, lift-served operations running May 31 through Sept. 2. After Sept. 2, lifts will only run on Saturdays and Sundays through Sept. 30. Highlights include:

- 36 miles of downhill single-track trails covering 1,700 feet of elevation.
- 18 miles of single- and double-track cross-country trails.
- a jump park and a pump track with features for all skill levels at the mountain's base.
- self-load, roll-on trays for downhill and e-bikes on Tamarack Express.

### Zipline Tours

Tamarack's [Zipline Tours](#) start at 6,700 feet above sea level and then zip down 3,500 feet of cable through a series of platforms to the valley floor, providing a bird's-eye view of the surrounding peaks, forest and Lake Cascade. Guests zip along at speeds up to 30 mph over creeks, canyons and the forest canopy while experiencing eight different ziplines, two suspension bridges and a 105-foot-tall treehouse.

### **Tamarack Waterfront**

Located on Lake Cascade, [Tamarack Waterfront](#) is the outfitter for the resort's watersports. Non-motorized rentals include kayaks, canoes and stand-up paddleboards, while the motorized fleet includes double-decker pontoon boats, 2024 Malibu and Axis wake boats and Jet Skis. Wakeboard, wakesurf and water ski lessons are available from the [Waterfront Sports School](#).

### **Guided Whitewater Rafting Trips**

Tamarack's professional guides provide [whitewater rafting](#) adventures on the 11-mile Cabarton stretch of the North Fork of the Payette River. Full-day trips last seven hours and include roundtrip transportation and a riverside lunch.

### **Guided Fishing Trips**

Guests can enjoy [guided fishing](#) for various species on the picturesque 30,000-acre Lake Cascade. These five-hour trips run April through October, and reservations are required.

### **Hiking**

Trails are accessible from The Village or via a scenic chairlift ride to mid-mountain providing beautiful meadow and lake views. [Hiking tours](#) for all experience levels are available Saturdays and Sundays.

### **Disc Golf**

A [nine-hole course](#) is located at the base of the mountain near the Discovery chairlift. Accessible from the main parking area near The Village and Wildhorse Children's Center, the course promises a fun experience for players of all skill levels. Discs are available for rent at Tamarack Outfitters.

### **Axe Throwing**

Located in The Village, the region's only outdoor [Axe Throwing arena](#) offers four lanes—each equipped with two targets.

### **Pickleball and Basketball Courts**

Just steps from the main parking lot near The Village are four [pickleball courts](#) and a basketball court. Courts are first come, first served, and lodging guests can check out pickleball equipment at Tamarack Outfitters for free.

### **Camp Tam**

Tamarack's summer program for kids offers a variety of exciting activities, including mountain biking, nature walks, arts and crafts, survival skills, golf, disc golf and more. Camp Tam provides four days of fun for ages 7-12 every Monday through Thursday, 10 a.m.-5 p.m., from June 19 through August 19. Single-day Saturday camps are also available.
