TAMARACK RESORT'S SUMMER SEASON HIGHLIGHTED BY GRAND OPENING OF OSPREY MEADOWS 18-HOLE CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF COURSE

Other new offerings include additional bike trails, a grass-lawn amphitheater and an outdoor lawn event space

TAMARACK, Idaho (May 20, 2024)—Tamarack Resort is set to unveil its much-anticipated grand opening of Osprey Meadows 18-hole championship golf course and spectacular 19th Gambler's Hole in July. While mountain, meadow and lake views remain, the resort and the original course architects from Robert Trent Jones II have reimagined the layout to enhance overall playability for all levels of golfers. The course features picturesque terrain, spanning lake, streams, and wetlands to aspens and ponderosa pines.

"The grand opening of Osprey Meadows will be the highlight of our summer, and we couldn't be more thrilled for players to experience all 19 holes of this beautiful course." said Scott Turlington, Tamarack Resort President. The summer season opens Memorial Day weekend, with nine-hole play on Osprey Meadows Golf Course, mountain biking on meadow trails, water sports and guided fishing on Lake Cascade and live music in The Village at Tamarack. Daily, lift-served downhill biking begins May 31, with guided ziplining tours and whitewater rafting trips following in mid-June.

Highlights this season include:

- **The grand opening of the Osprey Meadows 18-hole championship golf course + spectacular 19th Gambler's Hole in July.** Until then, homeowners, lodging guests and visitors can enjoy limited nine-hole play on holes 1, 2, 5, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18 and 19, along with access to the driving range and practice putting green beginning on May 25. Clinics and private lessons are available from Tamarack's certified PGA and Nicklaus Academies professionals for all ages and skill levels.
- **Four new downhill mountain biking trails—two black-diamond technical, one black-diamond flow and one green flow trail—**for a total of nearly 54 miles of lift-served and cross-country trails for all levels of riders.
- **A new 2-acre, grass-lawn amphitheater** and stage located on Tamarack's Ski Beach (formerly known as the snow front)—just steps from The Village at Tamarack—will be home to the **Tamarack Summer Concert Series**—a free weekly concert every Saturday afternoon— featuring local and national touring artists.
- **A 70,000-square-foot outdoor lawn event space** located behind The Lodge at Osprey Meadows, offering a scenic setting along the golf course for weddings, group gatherings and other resort-hosted events.
- **A walking and biking trail** connecting The Village with the Tamarack Express chairlift.

Returning this summer is Tamarack's summer program for kids, Camp Tam, providing mountain biking, nature walks, arts and crafts, survival skills, golf, disc golf and more for ages 7-12 four days every week between June 19 and August 19 (excluding the week of July 3). The camp runs Monday through Thursday from 10 a.m.-5 p.m., with single-day programs on Saturdays also available.

Lodging guests and visitors will encounter several exciting events throughout the summer, including the NW Mountain Archery Challenge, professional downhill bike races, Fourth of July festivities, a new art and wine festival, the annual Bikes, Brews & Bluegrass Festival and much more.
