# **Lift Operations**

## Season Highlights:

- **NEW** Mid-Mountain Lodge: A 12,000-square-foot lodge with a 7,000-square-foot deck, offering panoramic views of The Village at Tamarack, the West Central Mountains and Lake Cascade. Located at the top of the Tamarack Express chairlift, the lodge features dining, an event center and an exclusive area for The Club at Tamarack members.
- **NEW** Executive Chef: Renowned Chef Steven Topple has joined Tamarack to refresh and elevate the menus across all resort dining properties.
- **NEW** Sports School Programs: Expanded offerings include Olympian ski clinics, Season Stragglers Program, snow bike and Nordic skiing clinics.
- **NEW** multiuse trails & ski runs: 2.9 miles of new meadow trails for Nordic, snowshoeing and fat biking, plus six new runs (five green and one blue) for skiing and snowboarding.
- Extensive brush clearing, tree trimming and mastication across the mountain provide improved early- and late-season conditions, enhanced tree-skiing, and expanded ski-in, ski-out lodging access.

- Dec. 15, 2024, marks Tamarack's 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary winter season.

### Skiing & Snowboarding

Tamarack Resort offers 1,530 acres of skiable terrain across 2,800 vertical feet. Discover 56 named runs, ranging from open bowls, steeps, cornices and high-speed corduroy groomers to six named glades, natural tree-skiing areas, challenging backcountry and three terrain parks. The primarily east-facing slopes receive an average of 300 inches of snowfall and are served by seven lifts, including three high-speed quads, two fixed-grip quads and two surface lifts. Snowmaking covers 20% of the skiable terrain to supplement natural snowfall.

### Nordic Skiing, Snowshoeing & Fat Biking

Tamarack's Nordic trail system features 21 miles of groomed paths for classic or skate skiing, snowshoeing or fat biking. These dog-friendly trails wind through open meadows and woodlands with stunning views in every direction and are open daily from dawn to dusk.

### **Guided Ice Fishing**

Expert guides lead ice-fishing adventures on nearby Lake Cascade, taking anglers to prime spots for catching jumbo perch, bass, rainbow trout and more. Trips include guides, gear, bait and an ice shack. Snowmobiles are available for an additional cost.



### Basecamp

Tamarack's new daycare and activity center for kids up to 12 years old. Operating daily from 8 a.m.-5 p.m., the Center works with the Sports School to allow seamless transitions between lessons and daycare. Après Basecamp is available Friday through Sunday from 5 p.m.-8 p.m. so parents can Tamarack's après events.
