Grand Opening of Mid-Mountain Lodge Highlights Tamarack Resort's 20th Anniversary Winter Season

TAMARACK, Idaho (Nov. 4, 2024)—This winter, Tamarack Resort is celebrating its 20th Anniversary season with the grand opening of the Mid-Mountain Lodge and the unveiling of enhanced terrain, plus additional ski runs and multiuse trails across its mountain and meadow.

The resort plans to open for skiing by Dec. 6, with the possibility of a Black Friday opening on Nov. 29, if conditions allow. After months of brush clearing, tree trimming and mastication across the mountain, guests can look forward to improved early- and late-season conditions, enhanced tree-skiing and expanded ski-in, ski-out lodging options. Six new ski runs—five green and one blue—have been added, bringing the total to 56 on the mountain. Additionally, nearly three extra miles in the meadow extend the Nordic skiing, snowshoeing and fat biking network to 21 miles.



The new, 12,000-square-foot Mid-Mountain Lodge is located at the top of the Tamarack Express chairlift. Featuring a 7,000-square-foot deck with panoramic views of The Village at Tamarack, the West Central Mountains and Lake Cascade, the lodge will double as a dining venue and event center and include a private wing for members of The Club at Tamarack.

On Dec. 15, the resort will celebrate two decades since it opened to national acclaim as the first new destination ski resort in North America in over 20 years. To mark the occasion, Tamarack is hosting a mid-mountain celebration and offering Learn to Ski/Snowboard Day specials.

“Tamarack’s journey has been a winding one, but we’re proud of where we stand today and the community we’ve built as America’s only ski, golf and lake resort,” said Tamarack Resort President Scott Turlington. “Our team continually strives to improve our adventure offerings and amenities, creating lasting memories for our guests and homeowners. The coming decade will bring even more, with plans for expanded residences and additional terrain to the south of the resort.”



In The Village, guests at Seven Devils Pub and The Reserve can expect refreshed and elevated menus, crafted under the expertise of new Executive Chef Steven Topple. With more than 30 years of culinary experience, Chef Topple honed his skills in the mountain resorts of Vail and Beaver Creek in Colorado before bringing his talents to Valley County, where he operates [Ragazza Di Bufalo](#) and [Casa Rossa](#).

For those eager to hone their skills on the slopes, Tamarack’s Sports School is unveiling several new programs, including snow bike, Nordic and Olympian ski clinics led by Erik Fisher, the school’s director and a former U.S. Ski Team member and Olympian.

A new offering for families is Tamarack’s Basecamp daycare and activity center for kids up to 12 years old. Operating daily from 8 a.m.-5 p.m., the Center offers outdoor activities such as Nordic skiing, snowshoeing, sledding, and works with the Sports School to allow seamless transitions between lessons and daycare. Après Basecamp is available Friday through Sunday from 5 p.m.-8 p.m. so parents can enjoy Tamarack’s après events.

The 20th anniversary season arrives on the heels of Tamarack being ranked No. 26 in Conde Nast’s Top 30 Ski Resorts in the U.S., the grand opening of Osprey Meadows Championship Golf Course and the acquisition of 500 acres of prime development land contiguous to the resort for future residential units.
