Music sounds better with dream pop electronic duo **NEIL FRANCES** playing a **DJ set** on Saturday night! Australian-born Jordan Feller and SoCal native Marc Gilfry are the minds behind the LA-based project. Sleek, vibe-heavy indie-pop melodies meet funky

EDM and disco. Their colorful live sets are sure to get you groovin' and movin'; they "live for the dance floor," (Beatportal). The duo spent their whole summer DJing around Europe and now, they're ready to bring the party to the mountain! Glammed out Portland indie-rockers **Glitterfox** are also slated to hit the stage, and Boise-based groups **Deep Heaven** and **Red Caroline** open up the resort. **SOMETHING SPICY** and **PAXXWAVES** to DJ the closing Afterparty at Seven Devils.
