The Arling Center

Elegant turn-of-the-century architecture across multiple indoor and outdoor spaces, perfect for conferences, banquets, and retreats.

- **Grange Hall** (2,496 ft²) – main ballroom (265 seated guests), other rooms (160 seated guests)
- **Schoolhouse** (1,474 ft²) – flexible meeting rooms for breakout sessions (80 seated guests)
- **Chapel** (1,189 ft²) - large, single meeting room with plentiful seating (140 seated guests)
- **North Lawn & Arling Plaza** - scenic outdoor event areas (200 guests)

Mid-Mountain Lodge (19,000ft² indoor-outdoor space) – 180 seated guests—An inspiring alpine venue accessible by chairlift with panoramic views of Lake Cascade. Ideal for executive retreats, team dinners, and special events.

Osprey Meadows Event Lawn (80,000 ft²) – 300 seated guests – Expansive outdoor setting beside the golf course and lodge, perfect for large groups, team-building events, or casual networking gatherings.

The Marina at Lake Cascade – 75 seated guests – Waterfront venue ideal for summer events, casual celebrations, and private excursions on the lake.

Village Grass Amphitheater (87,120 ft²) – 500 seated guests – Expansive outdoor setting beside The Village and chairlifts perfect for concerts, team-building events, or casual networking gatherings.

Fern and Feather (1,474 ft²) – 70 seated guests –An intimate mountain dining space with refined ambiance, ideal for private gatherings and dinners.

The Reserve (2,714 ft²) – 85 seated guests – A flexible, modern venue suited for team dinners, intimate dining, black tie and private events.

Seven Devils Tapouse (3,000 ft²) – 200 seated guests – A lively indoor-outdoor venue perfect for large groups, casual conferences, and high-energy celebrations.

Rendezvous Food Hall (9,020 ft²) - 200 seated guests – A modern, open gathering space in the village center, ideal for large group events.
